Greetings Ohio SHRM State Council Members!

As I'm sure you are all aware, there has been a lot of chatter about the recent decision by SHRM to start their own new SHRM Competency Certification. The purpose of this e-mail is not to express my opinion about this decision, but to share with you what I have learned so far and offer the opportunity for you to join a conference call with Nancy Conway, our SHRM Field Services Director, to learn more about the situation. Below is a summary of what I understand about the situation.

- SHRM will begin offering a new certification in 2015 based on the following "competencies" communication, relationship management, ethical practice, HR expertise, business acumen, critical evaluation, global and cultural effectiveness, leadership navigation, consultation.
- HRCI will continue to offer their certifications.
- Individuals who are currently certified through HRCI will be able to get the new SHRM certification, beginning in January, 2015, by taking an on-line tutorial, at no cost.
- Individuals will be able to be certified both by SHRM and HRCI.
- SHRM will continue to offer pre-approved HRCI re-certification at their events through 2014, but will no longer apply for pre-approval of HRCI re-certification credits beginning in 2015. Individuals can still apply for re-certification credit of SHRM events through HRCI.
- Local Chapters and State Councils in good standing will be able to authorize SHRM re-certification for their own events.
- Local Chapters and State Councils will be able to continue to apply for HRCI re-certification credits for their events.
- SHRM is encouraging Local Chapters and State Councils to continue to apply for HRCI re-certification credit for their events planned for this year.
- SHRM is also encouraging individuals to maintain their HRCI certification if they are already certified and to take the HRCI exam if they are planning to do so this year.
